Safe + Sound Somerset, Somerset County's lead domestic abuse organization, is looking for a creative, energetic and organized **Residential Domestic Violence Advocate** to join our dynamic team. As the Residential Domestic Violence Advocate, you will be responsible for providing empowerment-based advocacy to victims of domestic abuse and their families. In addition, under the direction of the Senior Residential Advocate and the Residential Coordinator, you will be responsible for providing support to the Residential Program, including Safe House and Transitional Housing. Responsibilities include case management services and advocacy to clients as well as providing coverage of shelter, crisis hotline and all other residential program components. You will be part of an empowerment-based team that supports survivors and their families in a trauma informed, compassionate organization. This position works closely with the residential team to support our mission to empower survivors of domestic abuse and engage the community to break the cycle of violence.

The ideal candidate for this position is flexible, a self-starter, an effective communicator, has stellar organizational skills and has a passion for helping those impacted by domestic violence.

The following qualifications are required:

- Minimum of an Associate's degree in Social Work, Psychology or related field.
- Minimum of four years' case management experience, in a residential setting preferred.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality and adherence to the National Association of Social Workers Code of Ethics.
- Flexible schedule, may require non-traditional hours to meet the needs of the clients and the 24/7 program.
- Ability to work independently and in team collaboration.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite, Osniun or other client database navigation and web-based communication preferred.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) preferred.
